Three Patients First physicians have been included in the list of the nation's top family doctors. For the third year, Dr. James Turner, Dr. Kim Colter and Dr. Kelly Bain have been included in the Guide to America's Top Family Doctors.

The annual listing is compiled by the Consumers Research Council of America. The council uses a point value system to assess criteria valuable in assessing the top family health care professionals, including experience, training, professional associations and board certifications.

Dr. Turner and Dr. Colter are two of the three founders of Family Health Care, established in 1981 in Washington and Marthasville. Dr. Bain joined the group in 1997.

All three have been members of Patients First Health Care since 1998, when it was established. Dr. Turner serves as board chairman for the medical group.

Each is a member of the Missouri Academy of Family Physicians. Dr. Bain also provides obstetrics care for the family practice division.
