

Congressman Al WYNN TO HOLD PRESS CONFERENCE ON THE INTRODUCTION
OF THE CONGRESSIONAL DISCLOSURES PROTECTION ACT

Who: Rep. Albert Wynn (D-MD)

What: Press Conference to announce the introduction of the Congressional Disclosure Protection Act (CDPA) of 2007, the second civil rights law of the century. The CDPA is the second of a series of No FEAR legislative initiatives. The press conference will also serve as a reminder for the second annual Washington Whistleblower Week (W3).

Details: Rep. Wynn will be joined by the No FEAR Coalition (Notification and Federal Employee Antidiscrimination and Retaliation) and former federal government employees who have experienced retaliation as a result of blowing the whistle on waste, fraud and abuse in the Federal government. The press conference will highlight the legislation, recently introduced by Congressman Wynn to strengthen the existing No FEAR law to better protect whistleblowers.
